The Andrew and Merrill Silver Scholarship was established in 2014 to provide need-based support for an incoming student from Montclair High School in Montclair, New Jersey.

ELIGIBILITY

Graduates of Montclair High School in Montclair, NJ who have superior academic achievement and demonstrated financial need are eligible for this scholarship.

SELECTION

Each year, the University of Michigan's Office of Financial Aid will review the list of Montclair High School graduates who are admitted to the university and select the student who best meets the scholarship's eligibility criteria.

DEADLINES

- Apply for financial aid by submitting both the College Scholarship Service (CSS) PROFILE application and the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Complete these as soon as possible (preferably by March 1) to ensure you are considered for all scholarships.
