- Undergraduate or graduate student in good standing
- Full-time or part-time enrollment at the University of Michigan, Ann Arbor

- A letter from your union organization confirming membership **or** an essay describing your study and/or work with labor-related issues.

Deadline

Applications should be received by February 14, 2020, by 5 p.m.

Selection

Each year, the University of Michigan Office of Financial Aid will review the application materials and select the student who best meets the scholarship's eligibility criteria.

Notification

Scholarship recipients will be notified by April 3 2020.

Number/Amount

Two annual scholarships of up to \$1,000 each.
