The student must appear in person at The University of Michigan – Ann Arbor campus to verify his or her identity by presenting an unexpired valid government-issued photo identification (ID), such as, but not limited to, a driver’s license, other state-issued ID, or passport. (To Be Signed in the Presence of a Notary)
